1940 The current of the Ver Sacrum breaks out with the high school students; Father Bezler gives the final talk after the retreat in Olpe, called "Founding Document of the Holy Spring"

1955 In the Original Shrine, the Schoenstatt Women's Federation gave the newly gilded frame of the MTA picture as a coronation gift for the 40th anniversary of Schoenstatt'foundation (1914 - 1954).
