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Our time is characterized by alertness to everything that has to do with devaluation, exclusion and discrimination. But the more we focus on our uniqueness and value, the more we make ourselves dependent on the judgments and expectations of others. Why? We no longer live out of the conviction of values that have already been given to us - such as human dignity or childhood before God,

How much turning to the Blessed Mother creates an uplifting climate! In the Schoenstatt-MJF, the custom has developed that when you give a crown to the Blessed Mother, you will also receive a small crown in return. It is a sign, a reminder to always keep alive the basic orientation towards the positive, the valuable and dignified, and to live a decisive yes to one's own way and one's own dignity in everyday life.
